CLASS TIME

All children should be in their classes no later than 7:55am. The school opens for early drop off at 7:00am, the children go to their classes at 7:30am and start work as soon as they go into their classrooms. They all have a three-hour work period and it is important that they are on time always.

SUNBLOCK & SUNHATS

Please apply sunblock before school and send sun hats to school, please make sure these are marked with your child's name.

PARENT HANDBOOKS

We have a parent handbook for all new parents with all the policies and rules of the school. If you do not have a copy yet, please ask the office to send one to you. Please read through this handbook and hand in the last page with your signature, indicating you have read the handbook and understand the policies and rules.

WATER & HAND SANITIZER

We are still saving water. Learners may bring 2-5L bottles of water to school for drinking purposes.

We see quite a few learners who do not bring water bottles/juice bottles to school daily. It is imperative that all learners bring juice or water to school every day.

We do use hand sanitizer in all the classes, parents may send a bottle of sanitizer that can also be used in the classroom.

Learners may bring their grey water to school every Wednesday, we will return bottles home after we have used the water.

<u>GET TO KNOW YOU – Class Parent</u> <u>Evenings</u>

Each class has a date and time for discussing the rules of the classroom. Parents will also get to meet the teachers in that class, and other parents of the class.

The teachers will go through any questions you may have, they will also go through the equipment, rules of the class and explain the three-year cycle in each class.

EXTRA MURALS

STOP AND DROP/CAR PARK

The car park is a one-way system; please follow the correct way in and out of the car park.

We have three members of staff on duty to open the car door so that your child can walk with his/her schoolbag into the school safely.

Please remember to drive slowly in the car park as children are sometimes climbing out of cars from both sides of a car.

Please remember not to park in front of the school gate as this will cause a long line of traffic into the street. This is especially for Primary parents collecting at 14:00.

<u>All</u> preschool and primary children must use the stop and drop system at our school.

UNIFORMS (Primary)

Please make sure your child is wearing the correct uniform, that it is clean and does not have holes in any part of the uniform. Also make sure all clothing has your **child's name** on.

All children need to have a complete set of spare clothing that is season appropriate. We have a clothing bank if you are looking for spare clothing, where we sell used uniforms at a discounted price. Learners are also allowed to have their camp T-shirt as a spare in their bag.

PRESCHOOL/TODDLERS

Do not put your child in their best clothes for school. All children need to have a complete set of spare clothing that is season appropriate.

SCHOOL GATE

For security purposes, the main gate may NOT be left open at any time.

VISITORS

Please report to the office immediately, if your child needs to go to an appointment the secretary will fetch the child from the class.

SICK CHILDREN

Please call the office before 8:30 am if your child is sick. Please let us know what illness your child has especially if it is contagious so we can notify the other parents.

By law, we are not allowed to administer medicines to your child, if your child is on antibiotics they should be at home resting.

COMMUNICATION

Please do not Whatsapp any of the staff during school time as they are not allowed to keep their cell phones on during the school day. All communication should be done through the office only, even if there is an urgent message.
